We carefully assess the essential signage for directional guidance and, most importantly, for safety! We opt for corrugated plastic due to its weather-resistant properties and ability to be reused numerous times. This ensures that we don't need to place multiple orders throughout the camp season and guarantees that these signs will endure environmental elements without damage.

Post-summer camp, we review each sign's condition to decide which ones can be reused the next year. Damaged signs serve dual purposes as targets for air riflery and slingshots. Those still in good shape are stored until the next season, ensuring their continued use.



To reduce plastic usage, we've cut down on the number of signs we order. Post-summer camp, damaged or unusable corrugated plastic signs are recycled in our designated receptacles. Once collected, these recycled signs undergo processing to eventually be transformed into new plastic goods!
